

When:

March 7 - 14, 2015

Purpose:

Provide medical care to the impoverished adults and children of the Dominican Republic. Each day we will set up a mobile medical clinic in a different neighborhood; sharing God's love and providing medicine to those with little to no access to medical care. In previous years we have visited many batays, old Haitian sugar cane communities, where our impoverished Haitian patients are not recognized as citizens of either the D.R. or Haiti.

Who:

This trip is open to members of Trinity Presbyterian Church and Monmouth Presbytery as well as friends and family over 18 years of age. We need medical and non-medical personnel alike. Non-medical volunteers are needed to work in the pharmacy, as runners and helpers at the medical stations, in triage, and in crowd control.

Where:

Environs of Juan Dolio, a small town about an hour outside of the capital, Santo Domingo. Trinity has worked with SCORE International since 2011. SCORE (Sharing Christ, our Redeemer, Enterprises) has been organizing short term mission trips all over the world for over 30 years, helping churches share the Gospel and be the hands and feet of Christ. We will be staying at a SCORE facility, either the main compound where we will be housed dormitory style in air-conditioned rooms or at one of their other nearby facilities. They arrange our schedule, transportation, and provide translators.

Cost:

Approximately \$1,235. The cost of air fare to the D.R. is about \$500. SCORE charges \$735 for the week which includes all transportation, food, and housing. *Through our mission group fundraisers we hope to offset some of these costs.*

We are already accepting applications and deposits and deadlines will be fast approaching so heed that Holy Nudge.
